CONSTRUCTION, PROGRESS



Site barricading work completed. Site Signage installation is done.



H8 sub-structure work has started. RCC footings and 1st lift columns are in process



The Labour Colony, QA/QC lab, Site Offices, Material Yards, Safety Park, Safety induction room have all been set.



Material Procurement has been initiated (RMC - 145 cu.m. and Steel - 88.18 M ton)



Site Gate management and execution is being managed smoothly.



A Tree protection mechanism during actual construction activities has been set up by the PMC.



De-watering system is in place. Sedimentation tank and pumps have been installed.





PROJECT ADMINISTRATION





IITBAA has appointed an accounting firm (N.M.RAIJI & Co.) to manage the entire Project Evergreen Accounts and MIS reporting going forward.

The firm DSK & Associates will be the Project Auditor.



Expenses of Rs. 59.37 lakhs were incurred during August '23.

Thus far, ~ **RS. 1.12 CR.** has been spent for Phase 2 of the project (during July and August '23).
