


# Project Evergreen Monthly Report

## Construction Progress



Work for the substructure till plinth level has been completed for H7 and H8

For H21, the work is in full swing to get up to the plinth level. IITB has facilitated alternatively storage arrangements for holding excavated soil until the backfilling gets done



Protecting onsite trees during construction is closely monitored despite considerable site activity



Material Procurement, site signage, portable sedimentation tanks are in place & a permanent tank has been installed for the Dewatering activity. Dust management at site, as per BMC regulations, is underway using sprinklers.



Noise levels are checked and recorded twice a day to ensure minimal disturbance to the nearby adjacent girl's hostel



Illumination for Night Works and perimeter security with CCTV cameras is also in place.

## PROJECT ADMINISTRATION



Expenses of ~ ₹ 2 Cr were incurred during Nov '23.



Thus far, ~ ₹ 3.73 Cr has been spent for Phase 2 of the project (during July, Aug, Sep, Oct & Nov '23).

#### FUND-RAISING



On the Fundraising front, we have reached the Rs. 55 Cr. mark.



Monthly donations: Aug - Rs. 2.25 cr., Sept - Rs. 2.98 cr., Oct - Rs. 1.34 cr., & Nov - 77.41 lakhs



Pledges worth another Rs. 50 cr. have been received from individuals, batches and corporates, and will be converted into donations during this phase. 16+ batches have committed to support Project Evergreen through their Batch Legacy projects already.



In the form of support on building materials, we have received discounts on Cement from Ultratech Cements and on Steel from Tata Steel. Alumni from companies like IPMC, Orient Bell & Ravin Cables have shown keen interest to support the project with many more in discussion.
